

Video/DVD Policy

1. There is no limit on the number of videos/DVDs a patron, age 10 and above, may borrow. Library staff does not censor or monitor the video materials borrowed by minor patrons, and does not restrict the borrowing of such materials according Motion Picture Association of America (MPAA) ratings or any other criteria.
2. Movies may be borrowed for a period of seven days. TV series may be borrowed for two weeks.
3. Movies and TV series may be returned in the book drop.

It is the responsibility of the patron to pay the replacement cost of the lost or damaged videos. Failure to do so may result in prosecution according to N.H. RSA 202-A:24. As with other library materials, damaged or lost videos become the property of the patron once the library receives the replacement cost of the video.
